

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF
THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA
AND
THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS,
INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND WORSHIP
OF THE ARGENTINE REPUBLIC

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Lithuania and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, International Trade and Worship of the Argentine Republic, hereinafter referred to as the "Parties",

Wishing to contribute to the development of friendly relations and mutual understanding between the two States,

Recalling their commitment to the principles of the United Nations Charter and the universally accepted principles of international law,

Reaffirming their intention to develop a dialogue on issues related to their bilateral cooperation and other issues of regional and international character of mutual concern,

Recognizing the importance of continued cooperation between the two Ministries and of dialogue at various levels,

Have agreed on the following:

Article 1

Parties shall establish a system of consultations on the following issues:

- a) Widening and deepening of their political and economic cooperation and the follow-up of the bilateral agreements between both countries;
- b) Refining the legal and conventional framework for cooperation in various fields of mutual interest;
- c) Cooperation between the two countries at the United Nations and in other international organizations;
- d) Other issues representing a shared interest and pertaining to the promotion of bilateral cooperation.

Article 2

The Parties shall encourage the holding of consultations between their respective missions to international organizations, as well as exchange visits of officials from the two Ministries. The dates and other details of visits shall be first coordinated through diplomatic channels.

Article 3

During the consultations, the Parties may, upon mutual agreement, establish working groups or invite specialists, taking into consideration the specifics of topics under discussion.

Article 4

The Parties shall defray the cost of their visits.

Article 5


This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended or supplemented by mutual agreement of the Parties.

Article 6

This Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force on the date of its signature and shall be effective for a period of three years. It shall be automatically extended for periods of one year, unless one of the Parties notifies the other Party through diplomatic channels of the intention to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding sixty days prior the end of the respective period.
