

**Memorandum of Understanding
On the Establishment of a Bilateral Consultation Mechanism
Between
The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of The Republic of Lithuania
And
The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of The Great Socialist People's Libyan
Arab Jamahiriya**

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Republic of Lithuania and The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of great socialist people's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya (hereinafter referred to as "Parties");

Desiring to contribute to the developing and strengthening of the multifaceted relations and co-operation between the two countries;

Conscious of the usefulness of regular consultations and exchanges between the two countries, at different levels, on bilateral relations and international matters of common interest;

Referring to the joint communiqué on the establishment of diplomatic relations between the Republic of Lithuania and the Great Socialist Peoples Arab Jamahiriya on the 11th of June 2008 in New York.

Reaffirming their adherence to the purpose and principles of the Charter of the United Nation.

Have agreed upon the following understanding;

Paragraph 1

The Parties will hold bilateral consultation to review all aspects of their relations, And to exchange views on regional and international issues of mutual interest as well as on developments taking place in the regional and international fore.

Paragraph 2

Consultations on the bilateral issues will include all areas of mutual interest, i.e. Political, economic, commercial, scientific, technical and cultural cooperation.

Paragraph 3

Consultations within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding will be held on ad hoc bases upon mutual agreement, alternately in Vilnius and Tripoli.

The level, dates, venue and agenda for the consultations will be steeled through diplomatic channels on the initiative of either Parties.

Paragraph 4

When appropriate, members of diplomatic missions of the Parties in third countries, as well as representatives of the Parties attending international conferences and meetings will, hold consultations on issues of mutual interest.

Paragraph 5

During the consultations as set out in Paragraph 3 and 4, the delegations may decide to establish working groups to discuss in detail certain subjects of the mutual interest. Working groups will report the outcome of the deliberations to the competent authorities for consideration.


Paragraph 6

The provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding will be without prejudice to any other treaties or agreements to which the two countries are parties.

Paragraph 7


The present Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect for a period of three years. It will be considered as automatically renewed for successive periods of three years unless terminated by either Party, after giving a three months' notice in writing.
